We would encourage you to take a small collection in support of VI pupils around the world. Leave this to your pupils to decide the method they will use. A sponsored event, a straight simple collection or something more? If you do decide to undertake this Step 3 we will work with you to suggest ideas and to 'match' your pupil collection within a 'social enterprise'.

The overall focus is not necessarily large collections (although great if you do) but the value in us all doing our 'little bit' towards a 'bigger bit' (i.e. supporting VI pupils globally) and in us doing so together.

There are two resources we will work with you to send to VI Communities around the world. You may wish to pick a Country and make a long standing friendship with this school. We will work with you on this.

There are three resources we can send:

1. The physical 'Sightbox' with a surrounding innovation/entrepreneurial curriculum.(£400 plus transport)



2. The 'sightbag' an individual bag for an individual child (£40 plus transport)

3 , The 'ET' Box which enables children and young people with albinism to receive the prescription sunglasses needed to access education (from £80 depending on prescription)



Sightbox and Sightbags are a Rotary project whereas ET Boxes are the Lions. As the Journey of Peace suggests coming together, it is marvellous to see these two great service organisations come together with the combined aim of empowering VI young people.
